

Introducing the new R&D centre: adesso Turkey

adesso Turkey, a subsidiary of software and IT consulting giant adesso Group, is now an R&D centre. adesso Turkey, exports software from Turkey and will be the first R&D centre of the group.

After detailed evaluation and investigation by the Ministry of Science, Industry and Technology, adesso Turkey is now officially an R&D center.

Burak Bar#, who converted the Maslak office into the first R&D center in the adesso Group, states that the office would provide services to Turkey and the DACH region, which consists of Germany, Austria and Switzerland.

The R&D centre was developed with an investment of over half a million Turkish Liras. Artificial Intelligence (AI) R&D operations of the adesso Group will be conducted from this center in the future, which currently employs 30 people.
